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Action taken report on Feedback 2022

Introduction

Feedback report as presented by IQAC to the Members of Academic Council on 23rd February 2023 identified two action items as follows:

- **AC01** : For slow learners, many measures are already in place including remedial classes, additional multilevel assignments and mentor supports. For further improvement, the IQAC recommends all HODs to further enhance the eResources of Learning and provide access to all students so that they can access them on their own liberty and get maximum benefits.
- **AC02** : For improving professional and technical skills, IQAC recommends increasing the number of Knowledge-Imparting collaborations and MoU with corporate players.

This is an early review and status report on these actions as on 15 March 2023.


Objective

Objective of the review has been to present the status of implementation of action items identified from last Feedback report.

The Status

- **AC01** : Some lectures have been recorded for slow learners and some eLearning Sessions from public domain including YouTube have been listed out for complex topics in Computer Science, Electronics and Communications, and Mechanical Engineering. Respective reviews were conducted by HODs in their departmental meetings. Other departments are also working on the similar lines.
- **AC02** : MoU with organizations like CISCO and other market leaders of technical skills development have been executed.
