This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is entered into between CSIR-Indian Institute of Toxicology Research (CSIR-IITR) a constituent Laboratory of Council of Scientific and Industrial Research, New Delhi situated at Vishvigyan Bhawan, 31, Mahatma Gandhi Marg, Lucknow-226001 hereinafter called CSIR-IITR.

AND

J.S. University (JSU) situated at Mainpuri Road, Shikohabad Distt. Firozabad (U.P) hereinafter called JSU.

Sharing a common desire to extend and strengthen the functional relationship between CSIR-IITR and JSU, we the undersigned, mutually agree to share existing facilities and available expertise at our respective institutions, viz. CSIR-IITR and JSU by signing a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) on 22nd day of May, 2021 which reads as follows:

- The major objective is to establish a close linkage and functional coordination between CSIR-IITR and JSU for mutual cooperation towards the advancement of knowledge of the employees, faculty, scholars and students of both the institutions.
- CSIR-IITR and JSU will both provide intellectual and infrastructure support for carrying out academic research in collaboration in the areas of mutual interest. A prior approval of each research activity under such collaboration is required from the competent authorities of both the organizations. Mutually approved research projects will be executed without any financial liabilities on each other for recurring expenses after assessing the priority. The outcomes of the studies in terms of research papers, patents, products, etc will be jointly shared by the individuals from both the organizations.
- CSIR-IITR and JSU will encourage and provide facilities to faculty members of JSU and scientists of CSIR-IITR to explore and prepare joint proposals on thrust areas for funding. The technical activities and grant sharing between CSIR-IITR and JSU shall be mutually agreed while submitting such proposals to funding agencies. The outcomes of the joint research in terms of research papers, patents, products, etc will be jointly shared by individuals of both the organizations.
- The research orientation programme for the early and mid career faculty members of JSU may be conducted at CSIR-IITR and vice versa. The duration, frequency, adequacy and other modalities of such orientation programme can be decided on mutual consent.
- CSIR-IITR scientists can be Guide/Co-Guide for Ph.D. programme of JSU, subject to the fulfilment of norms and conditions of JSU.
- CSIR-IITR and JSU may jointly organize Seminars/ Workshops/ Conferences and short term training programmes on the topics of mutual interest.
- JSU may offer honorary positions of Adjunct/ Visiting Faculty to the Scientists of CSIR-IITR as per the norms of JSU.

- These arrangements shall be valid for a period of five years commencing from the date of signing of this MoU and its continuance will be subject to review after the expiry of the agreed period of five years.
- Any disputes arising will be settled by mutual negotiation between the two parties.




