

**Memorandum of Agreement (MoA)
On Academic Cooperation
Between**

JS University, Shikohabad, UP, India and MSLG College of IT Management, Addis Ababa, Ethiopia wishing to establish relations between the two institutions, agree to cooperate as follows.

Subject to mutual consent, the areas of cooperation will include any program offered at either institution as thought desirable and feasible on either side and that both sides will contribute to the fostering and development of the cooperative relationship between the two institutions. Cooperation shall be carried out through such activities as:

1. Exchange of faculty and/or staff
2. Exchange of students
3. Joint research activities and publications
4. Participation in seminars and academic meetings
5. Exchange of academic materials and other information
6. Special short-term academic programs

The terms of cooperation for each specific activity implemented under this MoA for Cooperation shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing by both institutions before the initiation of that activity. Any such MoA's entered into, as outlined above, will form appendices to this MoA for Cooperation.

The two institutions hereby agree on the following articles to establish the Exchange Program.

1. STUDENT EXCHANGE

- 1.1. The exchange program aims to provide students an opportunity to have experience of international cooperation and exchange, as well as to gain a better understanding of Ethiopia and India through education.
- 1.2. The term of study for exchange students participating in this program shall be one or two academic years but may be extended with the consent of both institutions.
- 1.3. The total number of mutual exchange students will be about the same for each institution during the term of five years.
- 1.4. The host institution has the right to decide acceptance of exchange students, by taking account of recommendations issued from the home institution for exchange students based on their academic record.
- 1.5. The host institution will waive the application fees, entrance fees, and tuition fees of the exchange students. Transportation, accommodation, food, clothing, and other personal costs including medical health insurance and medical care will be the personal responsibilities of the students themselves. However, the host institution may charge an aMoAnt for providing a laboratory, library, internet facilities, etc. The aMoAnt will be informed at the time of making an offer.
- 1.6. The exchange student is treated as either the research student or a specially registered student.
- 1.7. The exchange students will be subject to the student rules at the host institution, while on exchange. Exchange students will be offered the same facilities as local students.
- 1.8. Exchange students will study subjects or conduct researches that are pertinent to their field of study and are offered by the host institution.

- 1.9. The acceptance of course work (lectures, seminars) taken at the host institution and the measure of achievement attained there will be communicated to the home institution.
- 1.10. Any Intellectual Property developed during the joint activity will be jointly owned by the two institutions.

2. FACULTY EXCHANGE

- 2.1. The two institutions will actively seek to promote mutual faculty exchange for mutually agreed periods.
- 2.2. Faculty exchange may assume various forms, such as individual short-time and long-term visits of faculties, joint research, and development projects.
- 2.3. Both institutions will try to seek external funding sources to facilitate these exchanges.
- 2.4. Encouragement of the academic faculty to co-author publications, joint research activities, and joint project possibilities is subject to applicable copyright and/or other laws of each country, as well as rules and regulations of the perspective institutions.
- 2.5. The host institution will endeavor to, as much as possible; make available such facilities that will enable the faculty to obtain experience and training in its departments and institutes, including the use of its laboratories and libraries.
- 2.6. The two institutions acknowledge that in the absence of an external funding agency, all expenses for travel, living and allied costs will be left to the discretion and the responsibility of the home institution.
- 2.7. Any Intellectual Property developed during the joint activity will be jointly owned by the two institutions.

3. EXCHANGE OF INFORMATION

Information will be actively exchanged, including information for students, information on research and study provided at the institution, relevant information about faculty members and fields of research, and institution publications.

4. TERMS OF IMPLEMENTATION, RENEWAL, REVISION. CANCELLATION AND NOTICES

- 4.1. Details of the implementation of any particular exchange resulting from this MoA shall be negotiated between the two institutions.
- 4.2. This MoA becomes effective on the day it is signed and remains valid for five years.
- 4.3. This MoA will be renewed after five years upon the consent in writing of both institutions. Each institution may cancel the MoA by notifying the other institution of its Intent to do so at least six months in advance of its expiration. Projects in progress at the time of termination will remain unaffected.
- 4.4. This MoA may only be amended or modified by a written agreement signed by the representatives of each Party.
- 4.5. Each party shall designate a person or office to serve as a liaison for implementing this MOA. The Parties may disclose certain confidential information to the other concerning any future proposal made under this MoA. Each Party, therefore, agrees that the contents of this MoA and the negotiations concerning any future proposal remain strictly confidential and each Party hereby undertakes not to disclose the same to any third party, save for its professional advisers, without the prior written consent of the other Party except where

such disclosure is required by law (including, without limitation, under applicable freedom of information legislation).
