University Research Promotion Policy

1 Purpose and Objectives

- To provide financial assistance to students based on merit, need, or specific criteria that support the university's mission.

2 Scope

- Applicable to all undergraduate and postgraduate students of the university irrespective of their gender, religion, region, and demographics.

3 Scholarships and Policies

3.1 Government Schemes

The University shall provide required support to its students for filing applications and supporting documentation for available State Government and Central Government Schemes.

3.2 Chancellor's Affordable Education Scheme

Chancellor's Affordable Education Scheme is an Institutional Scholarship to the students of the university. The scholarship is offered to the top 20% students showing exceptionally well performance in academics or sports or extracurricular activities or any such endeavour that adds values towards the mission and objectives of the University.

3.2.1 The Process of grant of the scholarship

The registrar office collects relevant data/information from Deans of Schools and sends the nominations of the eligible students to the Chancellor for approval and further processing of the scholarship.

3.3 Spot Scholarships and Free-ships

The University offers multiple on-spot scholarships and free-ships to support affordable education for its students. The spot scholarships are announced by the Vice Chancellor of the University based on multiple conditions and scenario in the university as per regional, national, and international needs of education.

The Spot scholarships and free-ships may cover the part of expenses of books, travel, hostel, meals, club memberships, event participations and many other categories of the expenses necessary to ensure the active participation of students of the university in different education, research, and learning activities.

- **Government Schemes:** The students should approach Dean of Student Welfare (DSW) for the required information of schemes and needed support for application processing.

- Chancellor's Affordable Education Scheme: As per the process defined.

- **Spot Scholarships and Free-ships:** As per announcements/approvals from Vice Chancellor and Notifications from Office of Registrar time to time.

5 Reporting

Annual reports/list of the students granted the scholarships shall be notified from the office of registrar on annual basis.

6 Disputes and Complaints

Any disputes related to Government Schemes are expected to be resolved as per the process defined by respective Governments/schemes.

Disputes related to Chancellor's Affordable Education Scheme are to be reported to the Registrar Office for further resolution as per University Grievance Redressal Process.

Mere applying for a scholarship does not guarantee the grant of scholarship. The Chancellor and other officials are not bound to disclose the reason of grant or rejection of any application under Chancellor's Affordable Education Scheme or Spot Scholarship and Free-ship schemes.
